OBJECTIVES AND SCOPE OF THE SOCIO-ECONOMIC SURVEY.

The Lower Suktel Irrigation Project is a major irrigation project over the river 'Suktel' tributary of river 'Tel'. The proposed dam of the project will be established near the villages of Magurbeda and Pardhiapali in Loisingha block of Balangir district, which is 20 kms. Distance from Balangir Head Quarters.

In this project, 29 villages will be affected of which 15 villages will be fully submerged and 14 villages will be partly submerged.

Land Acquisition has been completed in 15 villages as per L.A. Act, 1894. In the remaining 12 villages land acquisition are being taken up as per the RFCTLA R&R Act, 2013 and 02 villages through direct purchase. All the 29 affected villages of the project are coming under the administrative jurisdiction of three Blocks namely, Balangir, Loisingha and Patnagarh.

Notification U/s. 11(1) has already been published in respect of Vill.-Bhatpali, G.S.Dunguripali & Banchhorpali The selected Agency shall start Survey & Census work in these villages immediately after executing the agreement with the authority and complete it within 90 days from the date of execution of agreement.

In remaining villages the Survey & census will be taken up only after publication of 11(1) Notification. The Authority shall intimate about the publication of 11(1) Notification to the selected Agency. The selected Agency in turn shall come to the office for a brief discussion and start the Survey & Census work in the selected villages. The date for initiation of Survey shall be finalized on discussion. The time-line shall be 90 days from the date of discussion.

Land in village-Tabalbanji will be acquired through direct purchase. There will be approximately 85 No. of Displaced Families to be identified from the village. Therefore only Rehabilitation Assistance Matrix will be required instead of detail Survey..Financial bid for Village-Tabalbanji should be submitted separately.



Part – A. **SOCIO ECONOMIC SURVEY OF SUBMERGED/ AFFECTED VILLAGES UNDER LOWER SUKTEL IRRIGATION PROJECT, BALANGIR**

To identify total number of Project Affected / Displaced Families & Landless as per Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (RFCTLARR Act 2013) in the villages coming under Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir.

- i. The survey must cover all the Household of each village.
- ii. The survey & census shall commence simultaneously in the Notified villages.
- iii. The census & survey field team will be responsible for collection of all relevant data photographs, documentation, compilation and report preparation. All the task shall be completed within the stipulated period of time 90 days (60 days for collection of relevant data, photographs, documents etc. for census & survey and next 30 days for compilation of data and submission of final report).
- iv. The successful bidder should be able to engage adequate number of field staff and other officers in order to complete the survey, census report in all the selected villages simultaneously.
- v. Whose land or other immovable property is being acquired.
- vi. Members of those families which are without homestead land and which has been residing in the project affected area continuously for a period of not less than three (03) years preceding the date of notification of the projects.
- vii. Persons who do not own any land in the project affected area but derive their income from working in the project area from three years prior to the acquisition of the land like agricultural labourers, tenants, sharecroppers, gatherers of forest produces, fisher communities, etc.
- viii. Entitled land holding families under forest right act, 2006 whose land is within project boundary.
- ix. Persons who have been allotted land by state government or central government under any of their schemes and such land are under acquisition.
- x. Persons who have been allotted land by judicial orders and such land is under acquisition.
- xi. To classify different categories of Project Affected Families (PAFs) on the basis of demographic data.
- xii. To identify village wise list of project affected persons (along with names of their family members) for all project affected villages, belong to schedule caste and schedule tribe category as per guidelines of Odisha Government.
- xiii. To identify village wise list of physically handicapped / *divyang* persons, vulnerable persons, minor orphans with name of guardians and deserted women in the project affected villages.

- xiv. To find out the impact of the projects on public and community properties, assets infrastructure particularly roads, public transport, drainage, sanitation, source drinking water, source of water for cattle, ponds, grazing land, plantations, public utilities such as Post Offices, Fair Price Shops, Food Storage, Go Downs, Electricity Supply, Health Care Facilities, Schools, Educational or Training Facilities, Anganwadis, Children Park, Places of Worship, Land for Traditional Tribal Institutions and Burial and Cremation Grounds.
 - xv. To take stock of all resources including the CPRs (common property resources) village wise and their uses in the existing villages and to make an assessment of the opportunity loss. To list out the extent of CPRs to be affected by the projects.
 - xvi. To determine the ownership over land holding, present land use pattern and the extent of loss of land (government and private land) due to the setting up of the project. Also to estimate the household's loss of production due to land acquisition.
 - xvii. To ascertain varieties of loss suffered by Project Displaced Families (PDFs) and Project Affected Families (PAFs).
 - xviii. To ascertain choices of affected families with reference to various options and provide baseline data for preparation of **R&R plan** in consultation with the Displaced Families / Affected Family concerned.
 - xix. The provisions of RFCTLA & RR Act, 2013 has to be followed in the preparation of the R&R Plan and Entitlement Matrix.

To qualify the technical evaluation state, the bidder must score a minimum of **50** marks out of **100**.

Financial Evaluation

In the second state, the financial evaluation will be carried out as per this Clause. Each Financial Proposal will be assigned to financial score (SF). For financial evaluation, the total cost indicated in the Financial Proposal and illustration.

The Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir will determine whether the Financial Proposals are complete and unconditional. The cost indicated in the Financial proposal shall be deemed as final and reflecting the total cost of services. Omissions, if any, in costing any item shall not entitle the firm to be compensated and the liability to fulfill its obligations as per the ToR Financial Proposal (F_M) will be given a financial score (S_F) of 100 points. The financial scores of other proposals will be computed as follows:

$$S_F = 100 \times F_M / F$$

(F = Amount of Financial Proposal under consideration).

Provided that the Bid is substantially responsive, the Authority shall correct arithmetical errors on the following basis:

If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of the Employer there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected;

- If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and
- If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail.

Any conditional Bids shall be summarily rejected.

CONFIDENTIALITY

TERMINATION CLAUSE

Right to terminate the process

Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir reserves the right to cancel the contract placed on the selected bidder and recover expenditure incurred by Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir under the following circumstances:-

The selected bidder commits a breach of any of the terms and conditions of the bid. The bidder goes into liquidation, voluntarily or otherwise.

An attachment is levied or continues to be levied for a period of seven days upon effects of the bid.

If the selected bidder fails to complete the assignment as per the time lines prescribed in the Bid and the extension if any allowed, it will be a breach of contract. The Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir reserves its right to cancel the order in the event of delay and forfeit the bid security as liquidated damages for the delay.

In case the selected bidder fails to deliver the services as stipulated in the delivery schedule, Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir reserves the right to procure the same or similar services from alternate sources at the risk, cost and responsibility of the selected bidder.

After award of the contract, if the selected bidder does not perform satisfactorily or delays execution of the contract, Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir reserves the right to get the balance contract executed by another party of its choice. This clause is applicable, if for any reason, the contract is cancelled.

Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir reserves the right to recover any dues payable by the selected Bidder from any amount outstanding to the credit of the selected bidder, including the pending bills and/or invoking the TDR/DD under this contract.



Consequences of termination

In the event of termination of the Contract due to any cause whatsoever, (whether consequent to the stipulated term of the Contract or otherwise), Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir shall be entitled to impose any such obligations and conditions and issue any clarifications as may be necessary to ensure an efficient transition and effective business continuity of the Service(s) which the Vendor shall be obliged to comply with and take all available steps to minimize loss resulting from the termination/breach, and further allow the next successor Vendor to take over the obligations of the erstwhile Vendor in relation to the execution/continued execution of the scope of the Contract.

The termination hereof shall not affect any accrued right or liability of either Parties nor affect the operation of the provisions of the Contract that are expressly or by implication intended to come into or continue in force on or after such termination.

Penalty

The Bidder shall perform its obligations under the agreement entered into with the Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir, in a professional manner.

In the event of failure to maintain the Service Level Agreement (SLA), penalty would be levied up to a maximum of 10% of the total service cost.

Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir may recover such amount of penalty from any payment being released to the Bidder, irrespective of the fact whether such payment is relating to this contract or otherwise.

If any act or failure by the bidder under the agreement results in failure or inoperability of systems and if the Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir has to take corrective actions to ensure functionality of its property, the Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir reserves the right to impose penalty, which may be equal to the cost it incurs or the loss it suffers for such failures.

Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir may impose penalty to the extent of damage to its any equipment, if the damage was due to the actions directly attributable to the staff of Bidder.

If the Bidder fails to complete the due performance of the contract in accordance with the specification and conditions of the offer document, the Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir reserves the right either to cancel the order or to recover a suitable amount as deemed reasonable as Penalty / Liquidated Damage for non-performance.

Dispute Resolution Mechanism

The Party raising a dispute shall address to the other Party a notice requesting an amicable settlement of the dispute within seven (7) days of receipt of the notice. The matter shall be brought to the notice of Collector, Balangir and his decisions shall be obtained.

Matter will be referred for negotiation between Officer nominated by Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir and the Authorized Official/representative of the Bidder. The matter shall then be resolved between them and the agreed course of action documented within a further period of 7 (seven) days.

Any legal dispute is limited to Balangir District Court's jurisdiction and its appellate authority.

Natural phenomenon, including but not limited to floods, droughts, earthquakes and epidemics.

Acts of any government, including but not limited to war, declared or undeclared priorities, quarantines and embargos.

Terrorist attack, public unrest in work area provided either party shall within 02 days from occurrence of such a cause, notifies the other in writing of such causes. The bidder or Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir shall not be liable for delay in performing his/her obligations resulting from any cause as referred to and/or defined above. Any delay beyond 30 days shall lead to termination of contract by parties and all obligations expressed quantitatively shall be calculated as on date of termination. Notwithstanding this, provisions relating to indemnity, confidentiality survive termination of the contract.

Failure to agree with the terms and condition of the Bid

The Selected Bidder shall, upon termination of this agreement for any reason, or upon demand by Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir, whichever is earliest, return any and all information provided to the Selected Bidder by Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir, including any copies or reproductions, both hard copy and electronic.

Conflict of interest

The Bidder shall disclose to Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir in writing, all actual and potential conflicts of interest that exist, arise or may arise (either for the Vendor the Bidder s team) in the course of performing the Service(s) as soon as practical after it becomes aware of that conflict.

Governing language

The Agreement shall be written in English language and all correspondence and other documents pertaining to the Contract that are exchanged by parties shall be written in English language only.

No Claim Certificate

The Selected Bidder shall not be entitled to make any claim, whatsoever against Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir, under or by virtue of or arising out of, the contract, nor shall Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir entertain or consider any such claim, if made by the Selected Bidder after it has signed a No claim certificate in favour of Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir in such form as shall be required by it after the work is finally accepted.

Publicity

The Selected Bidder shall not make or permit to be made a public announcement or media release about any aspect of this Contract unless the Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir first gives its consent in written to the selected bidder.

No assignment

The Selected Bidder shall not transfer any interest, right, benefit or obligation under the contract without the prior written consent of Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir.

Survival

The provisions of the clauses of the Contract in relation to documents, data, processes, property, Intellectual Property Rights, indemnity, publicity and confidentiality and ownership survive the expiry or termination of this Contract and in relation to confidentiality, the obligations continue to apply unless Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir notifies the Selected Bidder of its release from those obligations.

Entire Contract

FRAUD AND CORRUPTION PRACTICES

In such an event, the Project Director (R&R), Lower Suktel Irrigation Project, Balangir shall, without prejudice to its any other rights or remedies, forfeit the Bid Security or Performance Security, as the case may be, as mutually agreed genuine pre-estimated compensation and damages payable to the Authority for, inter alia, time, cost and effort of the Authority, in regard to the BID, including consideration and evaluation of such Bidder's Proposal. In such case, the Consultant shall forth with provide as a replacement, a person of equivalent or better qualifications and experience, and at the same rate of remuneration.


