1. Introduction and Background

Under the umbrella of the "Balabhadra Jaivik Chasa Mission," the Government of Odisha has conceptualized the Amruta Anna program. This prestigious initiative is dedicated to the revival and preservation of traditional aromatic and non-aromatic paddy varieties through certified organic and natural farming methodologies.

The paramount objective of this program is to establish a dedicated, chemical-free supply chain of premium agricultural produce directly to the Shree Jagannath Temple Administration (SJTA), Puri. This produce is utilized strictly for the preparation of Kotha Bhoga and Mahaprasad. For the Financial Year 2026-27, the mandate is being expanded to Bolangir district, necessitating the selection of a highly competent Community-Based Organization (CBO) to execute the field-level operations.

2. Program Objectives

- **Organic Ecosystem Creation:** Transition selected agricultural clusters entirely to chemical-free, organic, and natural farming paradigms.
- **Standardized Supply Chain:** Ensure a seamless, highly regulated supply of graded traditional paddy and pulses to the SJTA.
- **Capacity Building:** Empower local farming communities through rigorous training, demonstration, and continuous handholding.
- **Institutionalization:** Establish sustainable post-harvest management and primary processing infrastructure at the cluster level.

3. Scope of Work for the Selected CBO

The selected agency will function as the central implementing body at the grassroots level, acting under the direct supervision of the District Level Expert Committee (DLEC) and the CDAO, Bolangir.

3.1 Pre-Cultivation & Mobilization

- Cluster Identification: Demarcate and formalize contiguous agricultural patches (minimum 20 Ha per cluster) suitable for organic transition.
- Farmer Registration: Onboard selected farmers onto the ADAPT portal and Krushak Odisha. Ensure all beneficiaries possess valid Aadhaar and active bank account details to facilitate Direct Benefit Transfers (DBT).

3.2 Cultivation & Certification

- Input Management: Source and distribute institutionally approved traditional seeds (Gobinda Bhoga, Jhili, Kalajeera) and essential organic inputs.
- Seed Multiplication: Coordinate with ICAR-CRRI or OUAT to procure Breeder/Foundation seeds for multiplication at the farmer field level.
- Organic Certification: Register the clusters under the Odisha State Organic Certification Agency (OSOCA) and meticulously maintain all compliance documentation required for NPOP/PGS standards.

3.3 Capacity Building & Harvesting

- Training Programs: Organize and execute two-day non-residential Capacity Building Training (CBT) modules for batches of 50 farmers.
- Post-Harvest Infrastructure: Set up and manage primary processing units strictly within the cluster vicinity.
- SJTA Logistics: Procure the harvested, milled produce from farmers, ensure quality grading, and arrange secure transportation to the SJTA in Puri.

5. Eligibility and Pre-Qualification Criteria

1. Legal Entity: Registered FPO, NGO, Trust, or Society with minimum 3 years of continuous legal existence in Balangir as of March 31, 2026.
2. Financial Capability: Minimum average annual turnover of Rs. 50 Lakhs over the last three financial years (2023-24, 2024-25, 2025-26).
3. Local Infrastructure: Must maintain a fully operational permanent office in Bolangir District.
4. Technical Experience: Documented experience in executing cluster-based agricultural projects, specifically in organic/natural farming.
5. Manpower Availability: Must deploy qualified, dedicated field coordinators proficient in GPS mapping, data entry, and daily monitoring.

- Training Budget: Rs. 50,000 per training batch (50 farmers).
- Procurement & Supply Remuneration: Rice (Rs. 2,000/quintal) | Pulses (Rs. 1,000/quintal).
- Seed Production Incentive: Rs. 15,000/Hectare.
- Farmer Incentives (DBT): Ranging from Rs. 12,500/Ha (Year 1) to Rs. 4,000/Ha (Year 5).
